



Scholarship Award Guidelines & Application

Scholarship Guidelines:

EECU – A Community Credit Union is awarding two - \$1,000 scholarships to area high school 2012 graduates who demonstrate excellence in both academics and community service. Students must be members of EECU to be considered for a scholarship. To become a member, you must live, work, worship or attend school in Branch, Calhoun, Eaton, Hillsdale, Ingham, Jackson, Lenawee, Livingston, Monroe, Oakland, Washtenaw or Wayne County, Michigan. Applicants must be full-time graduating high school seniors with a GPA of 2.5 or higher. Awards will be payable to the student and the intended college or university.

Applications Should Include:

1. Completed and signed application form.
2. Letters of recommendation from at least two present or former instructors.
3. A high school transcript to document overall grade point average during 9th – 12th grades.
4. A letter of acceptance from an accredited college or university.
5. An outline including work experience, volunteering, community involvement and extracurricular activities, along with a section on any leadership roles held.
6. A 250 - 300 word typed essay. Please choose one of the four topics listed in #5 above and explain how it has influenced your life.
